

Trash Pick-up and Fishing Derby

Registration:

Units may preregister for the Fishing Derby by complete unit/individual registration form and returning the form and fee at the Scout Office.

Fees:

There will be a \$5.00 fee per participant which will cover patch, awards, program supplies and lunch or \$2 for any spectator eating lunch at the derby. ***Payments should be paid in full at the council office or at check-in.***

Participants that do not pre-register will have to complete a derby form at check-in table and are not guaranteed a patch.

Check-In:

Official check-in will be at Cole Park which begins at 8:00am and will continue throughout the day.

Pre-registration:

If you have pre-registered your check-in will be at the **Blue Marlin Table**.

On Site Registration:

Registration on the day of the event will be held at the **Yellow Fin Tuna Table**.

Check-in must be done by the adult/leader in charge.

Participants should be prepared to submit at check-in the following...

1. A complete roster of who is participation in the derby.
2. Present and keep for any emergencies an annual Health form with parental authorization to
3. seek treatment in case of an emergency.

At check in PAID participants will be given...

1. A Fishing Derby Patch (Not guaranteed for onsite registration)
2. Registration wristband

Fishing Derby Guidelines

Health and Safety:

Remember at least 2-deep leadership and that proper parental permission has been obtained in advance. All state and federal traffic laws, including the wearing of seat belts, should be observed in travel to and from the event.

First Aid station will be in the Barracuda area.

No firearms, fireworks or alcoholic beverages will be permitted by participants.

Portable restrooms will be available at the event site.

Youth Protection Training Note:

Participants should follow the BSA requirements regarding adult youth protection training.

Lunch

Lunch will be prepared by BSA volunteers. Please wear your participant wristband when you pick up your lunch.

Vehicles

All vehicles should be parked in the designated parking area. Vehicles must park in a safe manner and not block any exit/entrance roads. Once lots are filled parking will be along neighborhood streets across from park, please obey all signs.

Fishing:

Those who are 17 years of age and older must have a valid Texas Fishing License. A license can be purchased at most convenience or sporting goods stores.

If fish meet the legal limit they may be kept, if they do not the fish needs to be safely released back into the channel.

All catches are subject to the array of prize categories. Take your catch to the nearest **Whale Shark Table** to be added to the list.

Blue Marlin Table: Pre-registered individuals/groups

Yellow Fin Tuna Table: On-site registration

9:30-10:30 am Trash-pick up supplies distribution at **Spotted Trout** area.

Any gloves and pinchers must be returned to the same area.

Flounder Area: Bags with trash are to be dropped off.

Please tie the bags and do not fill them to where they are too heavy.

You can begin fishing once your trash bag is dropped off. Take any catch to the **Whale Shark** stations so you can be added to the category drawings.

11:45 am Lunch

Barracuda tent: Make your way to the big tent and pick up your lunch. You can continue fishing the derby. Catch check-ins don't stop till 1:00 pm.

1:30 pm Drawings

Take your fishing gear to your vehicle then head to the **Barracuda tent** for the drawings. Don't forget to bring your comfy chair or mat to sit on.
